

DR. MAURITS VAN ROOIJEN

Dr Maurits van Rooijen has executive responsibility for international and institutional development at the University of Westminster, London (www.wmin.ac.uk), which includes the development of the Westminster International University Tashkent (www.wiut.uz).

He is president of the Compostela Group of Universities, with almost 80 members the largest consortium of its kind. He is also president of WACE, the Boston based organisation dedicated to promoting work-integrated learning (www.waceinc.org) and vice-president of EAN, the only international organisation solely dedicated to the promotion of higher education to underrepresented groups (www.ean-edu.org).

Dr Van Rooijen's academic background is in 'green town planning'. He worked at his alma mater, Utrecht University and the Erasmus University before moving to the University of Westminster in 1993. He combined his London position with a vice-president position at Victoria University Melbourne (1998, sabbatical) and Leiden University (1999-2005; part-time secondment).
